

1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device (computer, tablet, or mobile phone) when you visit a website.

They are widely used to help websites function properly, improve the user experience, and provide website administrators with information on how visitors interact with the site.

2. Which Cookies We Use

The website vrachnis.gr uses cookies that can be categorized as follows:

A. Essential Cookies

These cookies are absolutely necessary for the website to function properly.

They enable basic features such as page navigation and access to secure areas of the website.

The website cannot operate correctly without them.

B. Statistical / Analytical Cookies

These cookies are used to collect anonymous information about how visitors use the website, in order to improve its performance and content.

Example:

Google Analytics – Used to measure traffic and understand user behavior (e.g., which pages are visited most frequently).

This information is collected anonymously and is not used to identify users.

C. Performance Cookies

These cookies may be used to improve the website's loading speed and overall performance.

3. How You Can Control Cookies

You can choose whether to accept or decline cookies by adjusting your web browser settings.

Most browsers accept cookies automatically, but you can configure your browser to notify you each time a cookie is sent or to block cookies altogether.
